St John Ambulance, Wright Street, Southport

All our main social events and Tuesday classes are held in the lovely ballroom at St John Ambulance Social Club in Southport. The 1125 sq ft dance floor is maple, and has just been refurbished in January 2014. It is well-known in the local area as a superb dance floor for ballroom dancing. The ballroom itself has comfortable seating at tables which are situated on the carpeted area surrounding the dance floor and is fully centrally heated. There are also overhead fans for the warmer summer months. You are free to bring food and drink into the ballroom, including alcohol, during any of our social events. Complimentary tea, coffee and biscuits are provided at the end of class nights, but you may bring soft drinks with you if you wish. Lord Street West United Church Halls, Lord St West, Southport

The dance floor at Lord Street West in the main community hall where we hold our Thursday classes is also maple, slightly longer and narrower than St John's floor, and a superb floor for class nights. The floor was fully refurbished in January 2014. The smaller community hall where we hold our Sequence classes is wood, and maintained regularly. Both halls are very well heated. You are free to bring soft drinks with you on class nights, however we do serve complementary tea and biscuits at the end of the evening.
